## **Questions Questions (Table Format)**

These questions are designed to be conversation starters (not essay topics) and so there are no wrong answers for any of them. They have been coded as Character Questions (CQ), Storyline Questions (SQ), Author Questions (AQ) and Self Reflection questions (SR).

I have also given questions a subjective "Difficulty" start rating as a guide only to reflect the complexity of the answer you might expect from your readers:
